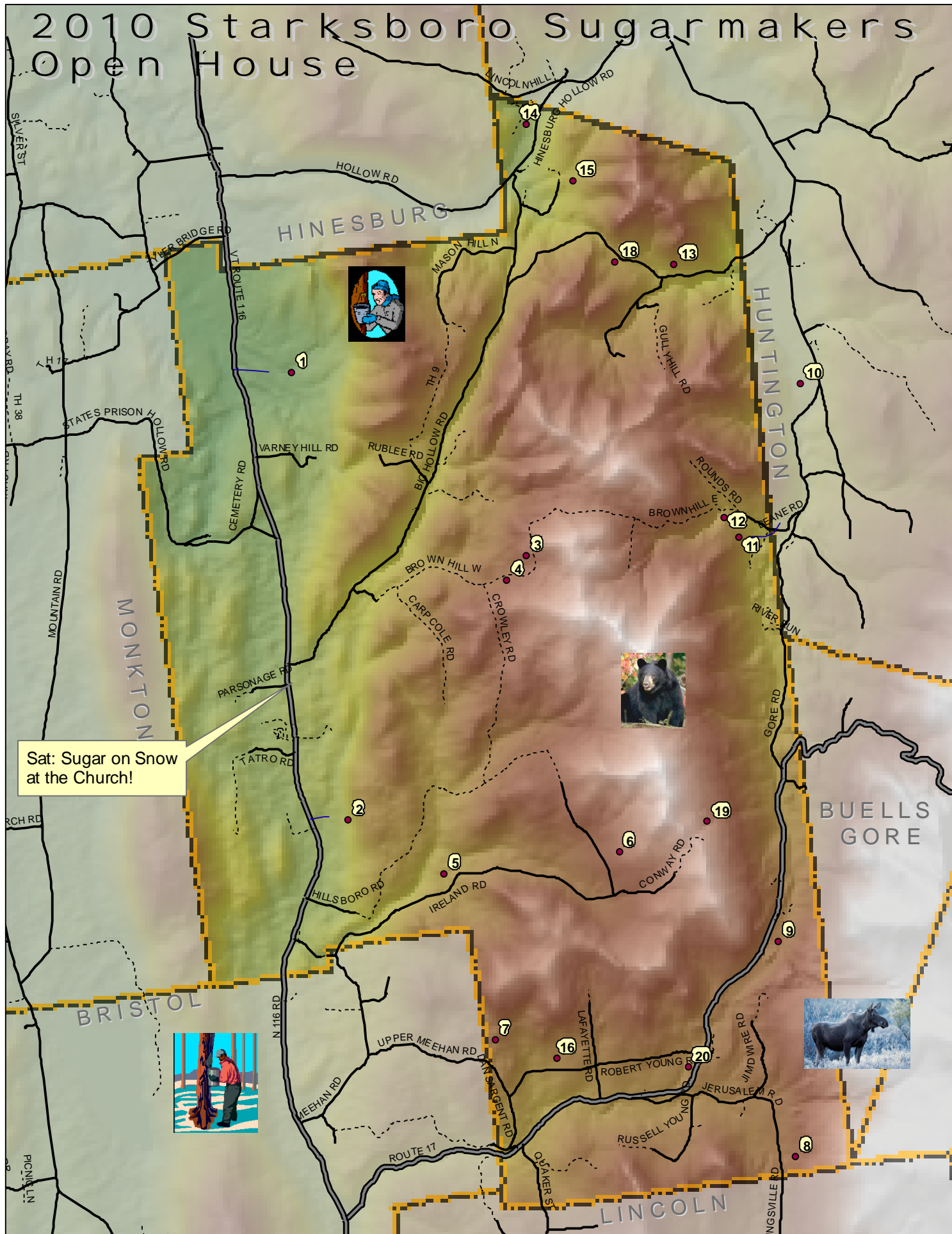


# 2010 Starksboro Sugarmakers Open House

1. Miles Russell. 6248 Rt. 116. Sugarhouse is 1000' in from 116. 1,000 taps. 453-2077
2. David Russell Farm 1248 VT 116 ½ mile N of Hillsboro Road. 250 taps with buckets, gathered with a team of horses. 453-2208 for wagon rides. David Allen's Sugarhouse at the D. Russell Farm 3,000 taps. 425-3369
3. John & David Adsit, and Kurt Kling. #15 School House Maple, 198 Brown Hill Rd. West. One mile walk if road is muddy. 1,700 taps. 453-2918, 482-2250
4. Don "Duffy" Dolliver. Brown Hill Sugarworks. Brown Hill West. One mile walk if road is muddy. 6,000 taps. 453-3794
5. Bernie Hurlbert & Jim Boutin. About 1.5 miles up Ireland Road from Rte 116. House is on left, sugarhouse is in back of the house. Park on road. 1,000 taps. 453-5324 and 482-2718
6. Jeff and Betsy Dunham. 3702 Ireland Road. Sugarhouse 500' from the road. 2,000<sup>+</sup> taps. 453-4219
7. Kelly Norris. At the top of the hill on Dan Sargent Road bear right at the house with green clapboard. Sugarhouse is on the right at second house (grey), walk across the lawn to sugarhouse. 6,000 taps. 453-4753
8. Victor Atkins. Downingsville Road. On the right 2.5 miles from Jerusalem Store. 1,200 taps. 453-5402
9. Chris Brady. Gyhll-Fenn Farm Rt. 17. A 1500' walk to the sugarhouse. 200 taps. 453-2330
10. Leon and Carroll Stokes. Gore Road, Hanksville. Sugarhouse next to the road, 2 miles east of Rte. 17. 3,500 taps. Carroll 802 999 3357 cell or home 802 644 5492
11. Dave and Susan Folino. Hillsboro Sugar Works, Mountainside Lane, off Bean Road. Hanksville. 5 min. walk to sugarhouse 14,500 taps. [www.hillsborosugarworks.com](http://www.hillsborosugarworks.com). 453-5462
12. Jim and Joyce MacIsaac. Highland Sugar Works, Bean Road, at the end of Bean Road, Hanksville. 4,000+ taps 434-3414

14. Mary Brace and Henry Emmons. Red Rock Valley Maple Farm, 160 Sugarhouse Lane off Hinesburg Hollow Road, 3 miles east of VT 116, next to Lazy Brook community. 8,500 taps. 434-2858 for current sugaring report. Maple products, cotton candy, sugar on snow, fried bread dough. 434-2382.
15. John Elder Family. At end of Ruby Brace Road. Fully organic making 100 gallons, 500 taps. 453-3625
16. Dan Faircloth, 439 Robert Young Road South Starksboro, sugarhouse close to road. 750 taps. 453-4893
17. **Not sugaring this season Seth Clifford. 950 Lafayette Road at end on the right. 200 taps. 453-8474**
18. Pete and Katie Antos-Ketcham, Shaker Hill Road, sugarhouse close to road. 350 taps 434-2333
19. Dan Baker. 667 Conway Road. Park in Town turn-around area. Short walk uphill to sugarhouse. 400 taps. 453-2630.
20. Maurice Trayah. Trayah's Rolling Hills Farm. 2131 VT Rte. 17 (0.2mi N of J. Store) 4,200 taps. 453-6100.
